"Where is your God?"

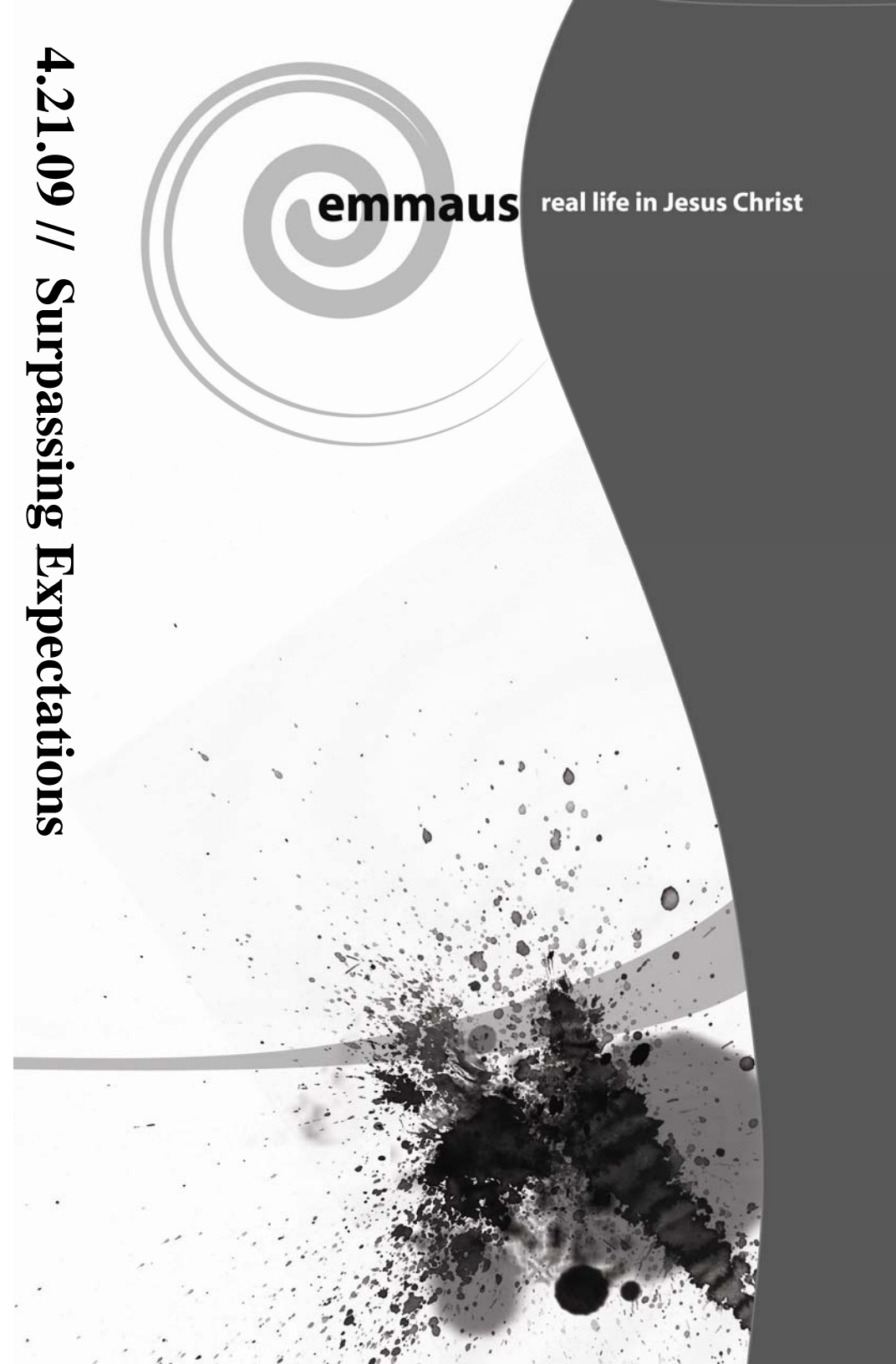
