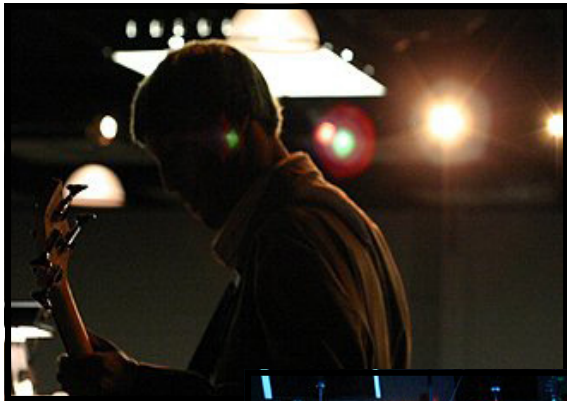

**Depth:** is for students who want to grow deeper in a relationship with Christ throughout college. Depth facilitates growth in two ways:

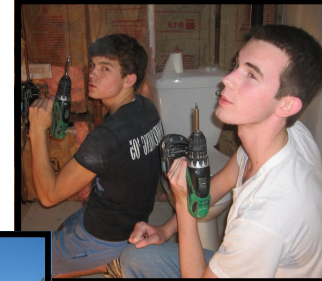
