## Weekly

Bldg B events enter through the **BACK DOOR** near Cherry Street.

### DvB *ADORE*

*Sundays 10:00-10:45am Bldg. B*

As we learn more about God, we fall more in love with him and *ADORE* him with our lives. This is a time of worship through song, teaching, and other formats. We also have donuts & OJ once a month!

### DvB *CONNECT*

*Wednesdays 6:15-7:45pm Bldg. B*

A time for all middle school students to *CONNECT* with each other and God through games, singing, messages and more! Teaching approach is a biblical view of relevant topics in middle school lives.

### DvB *MOVE*

*Sundays times vary Homes*

A place for discussion and relationships that go deeper and help students *MOVE* in their journey of faith. This happens in small groups that are divided by grade and gender & usually have two leaders. They meet in homes of students in the group (location usually rotates). Each week usually consists of a mixture of fun/play, sharing and discussion. Discussions are based on the message given at *DvB CONNECT* each week.

### CONFIRMATION

*Sundays 9:45-10:45am Bldg. B*

Available to all students who are in 7th grade or above and are interested in joining the church. Meets weekly (Jan.-May). The Confirmation class experience is one of both the heart and head. Participating in this class includes meeting with a mentor, weekly classes that explore the basics of our faith, retreats, class parties and more. We ask that you wait until Nov. 1 to approach people about being mentors. Registration is required and a class fee does apply.

Opportunities to *EXPERIENCE* ministry by serving others. We believe we are blessed in order to be a blessing.

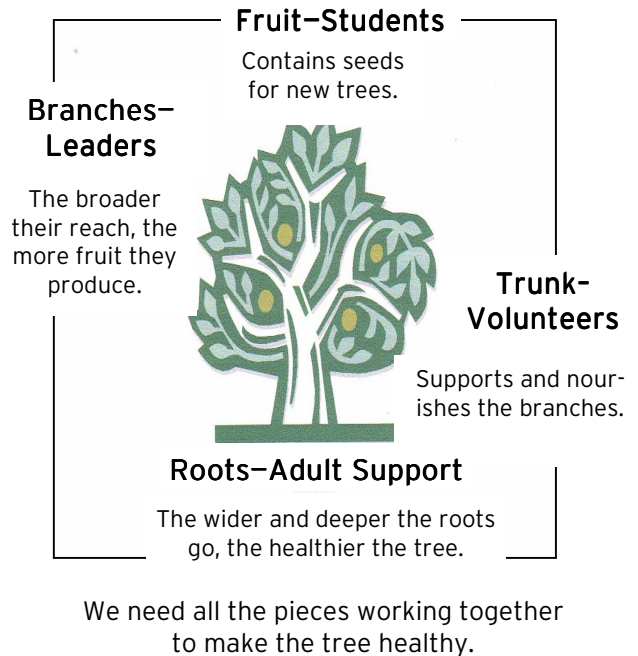
### Missions
