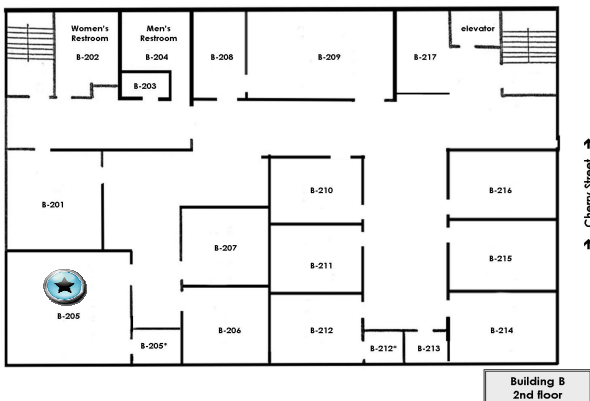

# Adult Sunday School Classes

**We encourage you to visit a class and find a place where you can take advantage of wonderful teaching and fellowship!**

## Eagle's Wings (Fellowship Hall)

- Teachers: Jim Johnson & Joe Moore
- Topic: Rotates through an alternating study of Old and New Testament books of the Bible.
- Format: Class of diverse ages which opens with worship and prayer, followed by Bible teaching in lecture format. An emphasis is placed on community (shared worship with mutual prayer and support) along with biblical study.
- Participants: Truly multi-generational, this class is open to people of all ages and comfortable for people in all stages of the spiritual journey.

## Table Talk and Listen (A-207)

- Facilitators: Tim Sechrest & Lori Gaillard
- Topic: The sermon text of the day.
- Format: Class begins with sharing prayer requests, praying for one another, and then engages in discussion-style Bible study led by prepared facilitator.
- Participants: Open to singles and couples of all ages.

## Students of the Word (A-208)

- Facilitators: Billy Rice, Dave Meyer, Martha Lowry, Jeanette Wilhelmi, Scott Wray
- Topic: Rotates through Old and New Testament books of the Bible.
- Format: A prepared facilitator guides discussion and application of Scripture text.
- Participants: Open to adults of all ages, with a focus on couples and singles with 30 years of wisdom or more.

## Covenant Class (A-211)

- Facilitator: Sam Blythe
- Topic: Various
- Format: Guest teachers are invited to share with the class using various formats.
- Participants: Adults with 60 or more years of wisdom.

## Younger Adults (A-215)

- Teachers: Bill Satterwhite & Megan White
- Topic: Ordinary Life with Jesus
- Participants: All younger adults are encouraged to come to this class! Not sure if you fit the "younger adult" category? There is only one guideline we are using to define young adult. If you call yourself a young adult then you are! We don't place emphasis on age, marital status, kids/no kids, or family situation.

## Adult Bible Study (A-216)

- Facilitators: Dick Glaze & Anne Rigby
- Topic: Rotates study of Scripture text and Biblical topics.
- Format: An in-depth and interactive study led by prepared facilitator.
- Participants: Open to all ages with a focus on adults with 50 years or more of wisdom.

## Choir Sunday School 9:45 to 10:25am

- Facilitator: John Lund
- Topic: "Simply Christianity" by NT Wright
- Participants: The timing of this class fits choir member's Sunday morning schedule, but every-one is welcome. Come even if you aren't in choir!

## Pathway (A-217)

- Teacher: Griff Shuler
- Topic: Biblical principles using topical study and Scripture.
- Format: Lecture with general class discussion and interaction (no small groups). Emphasis is on daily life application of Biblical study.
- Participants: Open to all ages with focus on adults who are parents.

## Discipleship Class (B-205)

- Facilitator: Betsy Hoppe
- Topic: Alternates Old and New Testament book study with occasional topical Bible study.
- Format: Each participant may study the selected text during the week to engage in small-group discussion on Sunday, led by rotating facilitators from the class.
- Participants: Open to all ages with a focus on couples and singles with 40 years or more of wisdom.
